Zion Baptist Church Re-Entry Protocols

1. The church building shall open Sunday, June 20, 2021, 9:00 AM Sunday School and 10:30 AM Worship Service.
2. All attendees are requested to enter the church building from the parking lot only.
3. The Health and Wellness Committee will have a table in the vestibule to greet all attendees, check for visible illnesses, and to give masks to those who request. Sanitizer will be available at the table.
4. Masks: Masks are preferred for all attendees from ages 5 years and up, unless there is a medical reason for not wearing mask.
5. Social Distance: The Sanctuary is set-up for social distance seating. We ask that you observe and comply with signage in the Sanctuary. We ask all attendees to employ wisdom in any acts of displaying public affection.
6. Touchless Tithes and Offerings: The Trustees will set-up a collection site so that you may place your offering in a collection basket before or after church. Members are encouraged to use givelify.
7. Worship Service: The whole choir will not provide music during service. The minister of music will select the individuals to provide music.
8. Cleaning and Sanitizing: The church contracted with a professional cleaning service to clean and sanitize the sanctuary (pews, floors, restrooms and windows), Fellowship Hall, Classrooms, Chapel and Restrooms. The lower level has been cleaned and sanitized.
9. Liquid Refreshments: The church will provide water or juice for those who request it.
10. Microphone and multi-use services: Sanitization will occur after usage.
11. Bibles: Bring your own Bibles or electronic devices.
