2 Chronicles 7:14, Matthew 6:9-13 & Col. 4:2

Week 1 ~ August 6 - 12, 2023

Day 1. Sunday - Give Thanks To God & Be Grateful unto Him (Psalm 92:1-2) Most gracious God our Father, how we bless your Holy name, and give thanks to you for your love, grace, mercy, forgiveness, patience, kindness, and favor that you have shown towards the Zion congregation. Thank you for your Son, Jesus. Thank you for the privilege of relationship with You. And thank you for your faithfulness towards us. Bless us to be a grateful people, knowing that every good and perfect gift comes from you. Bless us with a shepherd who is grateful to serve, and cast out the enemy from among us. In the Holy name of Jesus we pray and ask it all, Amen.

Day 2. Monday - May We Put God First (Matthew 22:37-38)
Our Holy God and Father, in thee do we place our trust.
Today I choose to bless You with all that I am. I pray with my brothers and sisters in Christ, that You would be first in my life and in the life of the Zion congregation. Bless us to seek to please and worship You, in our attitude and actions, conversation and conduct, in our giving and in our living, that we would learn to love You more and serve You better.

Day 3.
