Day 8. Sunday - Clean Hearts ~ Psalm 51:10

Our Father, You who have been patient with us according to Your loving kindness; we pray that You would have compassion on us. Day 9. Monday - Righteous People ~ Matthew 5:6; I Peter 2:9
