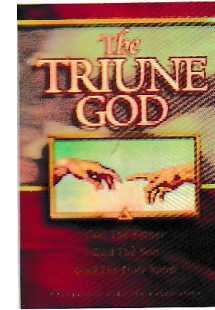

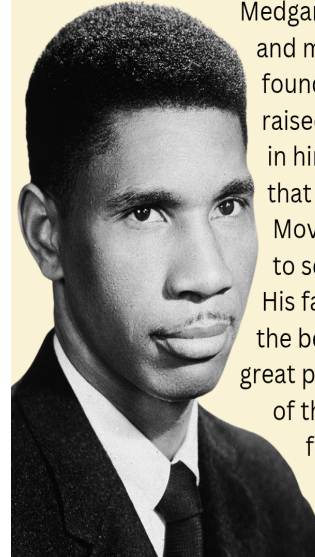

Christian Figures of Black History

Medgar Evers



Medgar Evers (1925–1963) was a devout Christian, civil rights leader, and martyr for justice. His faith in Jesus Christ provided the foundation for his courage and commitment to equality. Evers was raised in a devout Christian home. His Christian upbringing instilled in him a belief in the inherent dignity of all people, a conviction that drove his activism. Like many leaders in the Civil Rights Movement, Evers saw his work as an extension of the biblical call to seek justice, love mercy, and walk humbly with God (Micah 6:8). His faith was not passive—it was a faith in action. Evers embodied the belief that Christians must confront evil and injustice, even at great personal risk. Today, Medgar Evers is remembered as a martyr of the Civil Rights Movement, a man whose faith shaped his fight for equality and whose legacy continues to inspire those committed to justice and Christian love.



Fannie Lou Hamer



Fannie Lou Hamer (1917–1977) was a devout Christian, civil rights leader, and fierce advocate for justice. Born into a family of sharecroppers in Mississippi, she endured poverty and oppression, yet her deep faith in Jesus Christ fueled her lifelong fight for racial and social justice. Hamer was a devout Baptist, and a dedicated member of her local church and often turned to Scripture for strength. Hamer's unwavering faith gave her the courage to challenge racial injustice despite severe threats, arrests, and even physical beatings. She famously declared: "Christianity is being concerned about others..." Hamer is best remembered for her leadership in the voting rights movement and her powerful testimony before the 1964 Democratic National Convention.





Harold E. Pierce, Jr.

Harold Pierce Jr. has served in ministry for 17 years. After serving as youth minister at United Missionary Baptist Church for 7yrs, in February of 2013, Harold was elected to be the Student Pastor of the Greater Bethlehem Baptist Church, (now Greater Life Church) of Dallas, TX.

This role involves leading the teens and young adults of Greater Life with a clear vision and compassionate service. Harold was formally trained at The University of North Texas, Grand Canyon University, and Southern Bible Institute & College. He attended Dallas Theological Seminary, where he earned a Master's of Theology. Currently, he's in pursuit of a PhD from Anderson University and serves as Vice President of Student Success and professor at Foster College. He is joyfully married to Shun Pierce, and they have 3 Children (Kamaria, Harold III, and Maxwell).
